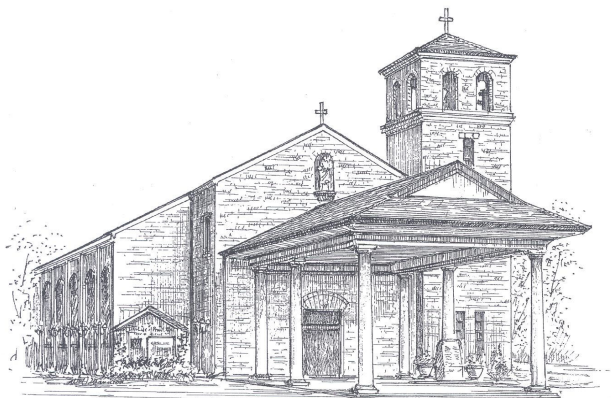

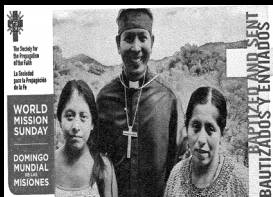

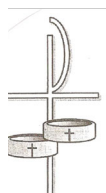
- No Glass, Ceramic or Breakable Vases or Containers Allowed.
